
FOSTER HOMES AS A MATTER OF URGENCY!!!!!



In December via GSR we heard about Tara & that she had one ear down ,one earup,approx 8yrs old & decided to give her a good home.

The Vet also found that she has a damaged shoulder & a loose tooth with an abcess under it.

I took her to dog training with Heather Stevens at wetrainanydog.com (formerly cannine connection).

In February she passed her Bronze good citizen obedience assessment.

In April she passed her Silver assessment.

In August she passed her Gold assessment.

This is some achievement for an 8 year old rescue.

She joined Heather Stevens "Phoenix Paws Cannine Demonstration Team", & has done several demos at Sinderby, Kirkby Steven & Thirsk this summer.

MONTY......This stunning boy belonged to Lynn Burkett who does so much for this rescue, he passed away in November...so sorry Lynn..xx




How true is this girls????

Hope all is well with you.


